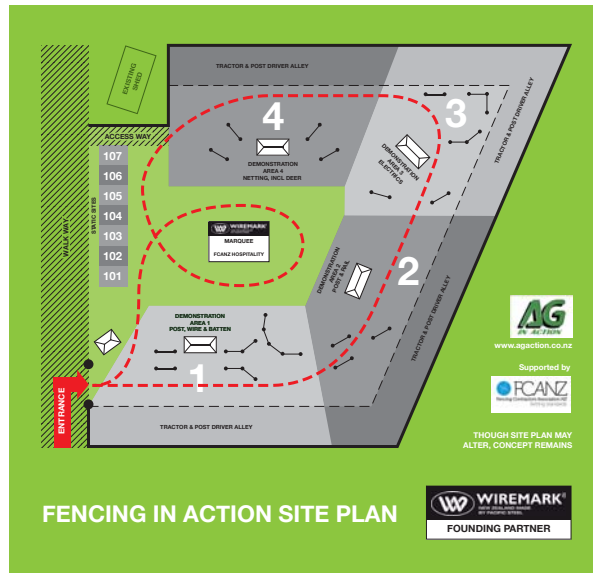

FIA covers 1.2 hectares within AG in ACTION and introduces a unique new concept with regards to how a Field Day event is structured with regards to the fencing industry.

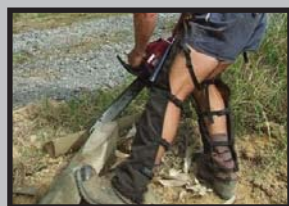
